1. Rules

The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (*RRS*).

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. Participation in the AYC Open is open to all boats of the Thistle, Y-Flyer, Snipe, Laser and Optimist classes.
- 2.2. Participation in the Snipe Class District 4 Championship is open to SCIRA registered boats and class member skippers who are in good standing with SCIRA for the current year as indicated by the SCIRA official online database or are able to present a current class membership card or its SCIRA-issued equivalent. Sailors will be allowed to apply to join SCIRA as part of registration and become eligible.
- 2.3. Early registration may be completed no later than April 22, 2014 at www.atlantayachtclub.org/ayc_open
 Late registration will be available Saturday, April 26th at the AYC Clubhouse between 8:30 AM and 11 AM. A late registration fee will be charged.
- 2.4. By registering for the regatta, all competitors agree to be bound by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and by all other rules that govern this event.

3. Fees

Regatta fees are as indicated on the registration form and do not include individual class association dues or US Sailing dues.

- 7.2. The USA Snipe Class District 4 Championship Trophy will be awarded to the first place finisher in the Snipe Fleet.
