



Notice of Race: 2016 Y-Flyer Mid-Winters

March 19-20, 2016

Hosted by Atlanta Yacht Club

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing and the by-laws of the AYFYRA
- 1.2. The following prescriptions of the national authority will not apply: 60.3, 63.2, & 63.4
- 1.3. Advertising is NOT permitted per class rules in accordance with ISAF Advertising Code, Regulation 20.5.3(a)

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1. Skippers and crews who are current members of the Canadian or American Y-Flyer Sailing Associations may be entered by completing registration with the regatta organizing authority.

3. ENTRY & FEES

- 3.1. Registration is available via the form at <http://www.atlantayachtclub.org/>
- 3.2. Registration Fees:
 - 3.2.1. The entry fee is \$100.00 US, with a \$5.00 discount for members of US Sailing or Canadian Yacht Association.
 - 3.2.2. After March 9, 2016 the late entry fee is \$120.00 US.
- 3.3. Entry fee includes all meals for skipper and 1 crew.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Friday, March 18
 - 6:00 - 8:00 p.m. Registration and welcome at the clubhouse
- 4.2. Saturday, March 19
 - 7:30 – 9:15 a.m. Light breakfast at clubhouse
 - 7:30 – 9:00 a.m. Late registration at clubhouse
 - 9:15 a.m. Competitors meeting at pavilion
 - 10:25 a.m. Warning signal for race 1 with subsequent races to follow ASAP
 - 6:30 p.m. or after racing, dinner and music at the clubhouse
- 4.3. Sunday, March 20
 - 9:25 a.m. First warning signal of the day with subsequent races to follow ASAP
 - No Race will start after 12:00 p.m. on Sunday
 - After Racing – Lunch and awards at the clubhouse

5. COURSES

- 5.1. The courses will be diagrammed in the sailing instructions and will be one of the following:
 - O – Olympic (also known as triangle-windward-leeward)
 - Tx – Triangle (x will be replaced with a number indicating the number of laps prior to the final windward leg)
 - W - Windward-leeward
 - WG – Windward-leeward with an offset at the windward mark and a gate at the leeward mark

6. PRIZES AND SCORING

- 6.1. Prizes will be awarded to skippers and crews first through fifth place in the gold fleet
- 6.2. Prizes will be awarded to skippers and crews first through third place in the blue fleet
- 6.3. Prizes will be awarded to the skipper who traveled the furthest to sail in the regatta as deemed by the Organizing Authority
- 6.4. The Low Point Scoring System, in Appendix A of the AYFSA By-laws will apply, modified so that each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. No score will be excluded. Five (5) races are scheduled, of which one (1) shall be completed to constitute a series. Rules A1, A5, A6, and A10 of the RRS apply

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1. The sailing instructions will be available during registration.

8. HOUSING

- 8.1. Unfortunately, due cabins still being winterized, the borrowing of cabins will be severely limited. However, we will attempt to provide housing to as many sailors as possible in cabins owned by Y-Flyer sailors. Camping is always available on club grounds and nearby hotels are also available. Directions

From the South-East (Atlanta)

1. Take I-75 northwest from Atlanta to Exit 277 (GA Hwy 92 North)
2. Turn right at the top of exit onto Hwy 92 and go approximately .5 miles. Cross the new bridge. Turn left at the stoplight onto Hunt Road. Just past the stop sign, the road becomes Kellogg Creek Road and bears sharply right. Go 1.2 miles.
3. Turn LEFT onto Yacht Club Drive at the sailboat sign. Go 1.2 miles to the AYC entrance

From the North-West (Chattanooga)

1. Take I-75 southeast towards Atlanta to Exit 277 (GA Hwy 92 North)
2. Turn LEFT at top of exit onto Hwy 92 and go approximately 1.3 miles, crossing the interstate and the new bridge. Turn left at the stoplight onto Hunt Road. Just past the stop sign, the road becomes Kellogg Creek Road and bears sharply right. Go 1.2 miles.
3. Turn LEFT onto Yacht Club Drive at the sailboat sign. Go 1.2 miles to the AYC entrance
