

Notice of Race

1 Rules

1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in the current version of *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 Sailing Instructions

2.1 The sailing instructions will be available by November 2ndth online at <u>https://www.atlantayachtclub.org/no-more-turkey</u>.

3 Communication

3.1 The online official notice board is located at <u>https://www.atlantayachtclub.org/no-more-turkey</u>.

4 Eligibility and Entry

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the Laser / ILCA and Sunfish class.
- 4.2 All Laser / ILCA rigs are allowed. A minimum of three entries of the same rig constitutes a separate fleet.
- 4.3 Class legal sails are not required.
- 4.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form and submitting it, together with the required fee by end of day Tuesday, November 7th. Registration is available on-site Saturday morning.
- 4.5 Boats may enter the event by registering online <u>https://www.atlantayachtclub.org/no-more-turkey</u>.
- 4.6 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

5 Fees

- 5.1 The entry fee is \$25 per boat for adults, \$20 per boat for juniors. Saturday dinner and Sunday lunch are included in the registration fee.
- 5.2 Non-sailors are welcome to join for the Saturday dinner (\$12) and/or Sunday lunch (\$8). Please register online.
- 5.3 Online payment and credit card options are available and encouraged.

6 Schedule

- 6.1 Saturday, November 11 (Eastern Standard Time)
 - 0930 Registration open in the clubhouse
 - 1030 Registration closed
 - 1230 Competitors Meeting at the Point Viewing Pavilion Lunch (on your own, not provided)
 - 1257 Warning signal for first race.

More races to follow. We will try for six races on Saturday. No races will start after 1600. BBQ Burritos, Cole Slaw, Baked Bean, Pickles, Sauces, Chips, Salad and Desserts!

- 1930 Bonfire at BBQ Pavilion
- 6.2 Sunday, November 12 (Eastern Standard Time)
 - 0857 Warning signal for first race. More races to follow. We will try for three races on Sunday. No races will start after 1200.

After races on Sunday, awards will be presented and lunch served in the clubhouse (approximately 45 minutes after the last race).

7 Scoring

- 7.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.2 If 5 or more races are completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. If less than 5 races are completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores (no throw-outs).

8 Risk Statement

8.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing Authority will not accept any liability for damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

9 Prizes

- 9.1 Prizes will be given as follows:
 - 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place prizes for each fleet consisting of 7 or more boats, or
 - 1^{st} and 2^{nd} place prizes for each fleet consisting of 4 6 boats, or
 - 1st place prize for each fleet consisting of 3 boats

10 Additional Information

- 10.1 All Sailors shall be required to wear a Coast Guard approved life jacket while on the water.
- 10.2 Wet/dry suits are strongly recommended due to potential cold temperatures in November on Lake Allatoona.
- 10.3 AYC is 17 miles north of Atlanta. Take Exit 277 (Ga HWY 92) off I-75. Go east on Hwy 92 and turn left onto Hunt Rd. Go .2 miles, through Stop sign and immediately bear right through hairpin turn; the road changes to Kellogg Creek Rd. Go 1 mile and turn left onto Yacht Club Drive. Look for entrance to AYC on the right after one mile.
- 10.4 Club Gate code will be set to 1123# for the weekend.
- 10.5 AYC prohibits firearms, and motorcycles on club premises.
- 10.6 It is the responsibility of AYC members/guests to take appropriate measures to safeguard their personal property while on club premises.
- 10.7 Camping and showers are available free at AYC.
- 10.8 Hotels are just 5 minutes away located at I-75 and Highway 92.
