

**NOTICE OF RACE**  
**2021 AYC Junior Championship**  
**September 4, 2020**

**1. Rules**

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

1.2 Appendix V will apply. Additional rules may also be changed and will be noted in the Sailing Instructions.

**2. Eligibility and Entry**

2.1 Participation in the AYC Junior Championship is open to all AYC Juniors and Grand Children of members. The 2021 Championship will use provided 420 Class Boats.

2.2 The skipper is responsible to find a crew. The crew must be of junior age. Crew are preferred to be club member juniors but not required.

2.3 The 12 AYC 420's will be available on a first come, first served basis once online registration is available.

2.4 Boats will be randomly assigned the morning of the regatta and each skipper/crew team will sail the same boat for all races in the regatta.

**3. Fees:**

There is no fee for the AYC Junior Championship.

Competitors meeting 9:15 AM at the point (social distancing heavily encouraged)

Warning Signal 1st start of 1st Race 9:55am

A Lunch break will be given at approximately 12:00pm

Afternoon Warning Signal 12:55pm

No warning signal will sound after 4:00pm

## **5. Sailing Instructions and Courses**

5.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available at Check-In and Registration in the AYC Clubhouse.

5.2 Preliminary Sailing Instructions will be posted on the AYC Junior Championship Regatta website.

5.3 The courses will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

## **6. Scoring**

One race shall constitute a regatta. No score will be excluded.

## **7. Penalties**

RRS Appendix V (both V1 and V2), Alternative Penalties, will apply

## **8. Prizes**

Trophies will be awarded to the Top 3 Finishers.
