2023 AMYA EC12 Region 3 Championship and Gone with the Wind Regatta March 31 - April 1 and 2

1. Rules:

- **1.1** The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing as modified by Appendix E.
- 1.2 The EC12 Class Rules.

2. Eligibility:

- **2.1** Skippers must be a current paid member of AMYA or, in the case of international entries, a current member of the national sailing authority they are representing.
- **2.2** Boat measurement certificates are required and shall be available, if requested.

3. Entry:

- **3.1 Skipper Entry Fee is \$55.** Includes Friday night Welcome Party with heavy hors d'oeuvres, complimentary wine, beer and soft drinks; Saturday and Sunday continental breakfasts; Saturday and Sunday lunches; Saturday dinner, plus Saturday after the race social with complimentary wine, beer and soft drinks.
- 3.2 A Guest Meal package is \$30 for all meals and events, (Saturday dinner only is \$15).
- **3.3** Register on the AYC web site, https://atlantavachtclub.org/GWTW/
- **3.3** Registration deadline is **Friday, March 24, 2023**.

4. Racing Format:

- **4.1** If more than 18 boats compete, racing will be conducted under the Equal Opportunity Racing System (EORS); otherwise all boats will start together as one fleet.
- **4.2** The current National Seeding List will be used, if heats are sailed.

5.1 AYC Beach.

6. Sailing Instructions (SIs)

6.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at on-site check-in. (AYC Clubhouse).

7. Bow Bumpers

7.1 The use of Bow Bumpers is highly recommended, but is not mandatory for this regatta.

8. Scoring:

8.1 The Low Point Scoring System, as set forth by Appendix A of the RRS, will apply. One (1) worst score, excluding penalty points, will be deducted from each skipper's overall score for every 8 races sailed.

9. Awards:

9.1 Awards will be presented to the top 3 skippers if 15 or less boats are registered by March 24. In the event 16 or more boats are registered by March 24, awards will be presented to the top 5 skippers.
